

2021 AAPA President's Report

This report presents the major accomplishments, activities, and partnerships of the Asian Association for Public Administration for the past year from 2020 to 2021. AAPA has completed a successful transition of leadership and the Secretariat Office. With the new leadership, AAPA has organized and hosted a series of academic events in partnership, and with the strong support of universities and colleges in Asia where many of its board members are based. AAPA has also analyzed current partnerships, connect with each partner, and also try to widen the AAPA network in order to better serve all AAPA members.

1. Transition of AAPA Secretariat Office

With the very kind help of the previous AAPA Secretariat Office, the AAPA secretariat office has been transferred to China Institute for Urban Governance of Shanghai Jiao Tong University led by Professor Jiannan Wu. After a lot of efforts to look for different companies through various channels, the Secretariat Office finally found the most suitable company to complete the rebuilding of the website. New Secretariat Office has transferred the website database from South Korea to China and make sure it is online smoothly in early March, 2021. The office has transferred all the important files and financial resources from the previous Secretariat. The successful transition of the AAPA Secretariat office has made sure the stabilization of the organization and its future development.

2. AAPA Annual Conference and Workshops

2.1 Taking off from the 2020 AAPA Annual Conference in Shanghai



On September 24th and 25th, the Annual Conference of the Asian Association for Public Administration (AAPA) 2020 online annual conference was successfully held. Hundreds of representatives from 17 different countries and regions, including South Korea, the United States, Philippines, India, Thailand, and Australia, exchanged their views on the theme of "Towards Sustainable Asian Urban Governance: Emerging Theories and Innovative Practices". This annual conference was co-sponsored by the Asian Association for Public Administration, China Institute for Urban Governance of Shanghai Jiao Tong University, the School of International and Public Affairs of Shanghai Jiao Tong University, and the China-America Association for Public Affairs.



2.2 Cooperation with Professor Alexander Kochegura closely for the 2021 Annual meeting in Moscow, Russia

AAPA Secretariat Office has worked very closely with Professor Alexander Kochegura and his Local Committee from 2020 to 2021, especially with the



preparation and issue of Call for Papers, the promotion of the 2021 AAPA conference, the formation of the 2021 AAPA Academic Committee as well as other organizing work of the forthcoming conference.

2.3 2020 & 2021 Joint Seminar with United Nations, the Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UNDESA) on Digital Governance

After taking office, Professor Jiannan Wu has connected with UNDESA through its Division for Public Institutions and Digital Government (DPIDG). Professor Jiannan Wu has also contacted Director Juwang Zhu several times. On November 1st, 2020, AAPA has hosted a seminar on Digital Governance in the 2020 Global Cities Forum with the joint efforts of Shanghai Big Data Center, Institute of Governmental Studies of Korea University, China Institute for Urban Governance of Shanghai Jiao Tong University. Director Juwang Zhu from UNDESA also gave an opening remark at this seminar at 1 a.m. EST time, which marks the great value of UNDESA and AAPA cooperation. At the same time of 2021 Global Cities Forum, AAPA plans to host a similar seminar on Digital Transformation with joint efforts with UNDESA.

3. Strategic Collaboration

3.1 Collaboration with the United Nations (UN).


On April 22nd, AAPA Secretariat Office has virtually exchanged and signed updated MOU with the United Nations, through the Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UNDESA), through its Division for Public Institutions and Digital Government (DPIDG). Both sides have agreed to continue the cooperation and to strengthen the partnerships in support of Agenda 2030 and the Sustainable Development Goals.

On September 7, Prof. Jiannan Wu, President of AAPA, held an online meeting with



Director Juwang Zhu of UNDESA DPIDG, and both parties reached the following consensus: 1. Director Zhu Juwang welcome AAPA members to publish the latest teaching materials, achievements, seminars, journals and other materials on the UNPAN network platform, and all outstanding achievements can be promoted on the UNPAN platform; 2. AAPA will cooperate with UNDESA in the near future to kick off conferences and other related activities, and UNDESA invite AAPA to participate in next year's UN expert committee meeting and jointly prepare next year's seminar.

With the kind efforts of AAPA US Chapter Head, Professor Bok Gyo Jeong, AAPA has updated of AAPA information in both the UN's website and the AAPA website; AAPA has also provided information needed for the review of AAPA Quadrennial Report. Professor Bok Gyo Jeong has been keeping a close eye on the reviewing of AAPA's UN ECOSOC's Special Consultative Status. On October 5th, 2021, the AAPA's quadrennial report was taken note and the official process including correspondence with the NGO Committee is complete. Thanks to Professor Bok Gyo Jeong's consistence efforts, AAPA has successfully completed our quadrennial review process.





3.2 Contact all partners, and try to talk with each partner and improve the cooperation.

For example, Meeting with president of The Central American Institute of Public Administration (ICAP), Professor Alexander Lopez; International Public Policy Association (IPPA), Professor Guy Peters; the Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Kyrgyz Republic (APAPKR) from Kyrgyz Republic, Professor AKMATALIEV Almazbek, as well as the Director of UNDESA DPIDG,

It has been a hard year due to the COVID-19 and so we chose to meet the partners online. On March 3rd, 2021, AAPA President, Professor Jiannan Wu met Professor Alexander Lopez from the Central American Institute of Public Administration (ICAP). Professor Lopez introduced the background of ICAP and its current situation, especially its academic programs.

On May 8th, 2021, AAPA President, Professor Jiannan Wu had an online meeting with the founding president of International Public Policy Association (IPPA), Professor Guy Peters. Professor Xin Liang and Ms. Boming Xie also attended the meeting. Professor Wu introduced the history and current situation of AAPA and invited Professor Peters to join the coming 2021 AAPA annual conference in Russia. Professor Peters also introduced himself as well as IPPA briefly. He agreed to attend the coming 2021 annual AAPA conference and also invited members from AAPA to attend IPPA 2021 conference in Barcelona, Spain. Professor Peters also introduced the summer school and workshops that IPPA plans to host next year and invited AAPA to cooperate on future events.





Also, On May 26th, 2021, AAPA President, Professor Jiannan Wu had an online meeting with the President of the Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Kyrgyz Republic (APAPKR), Rector, Professor AKMATALIEV Almazbek. Department for Regulations, Protocol and External Relations (ORPER), Professor Xin Liang and Ms. Boming Xie also attended the meeting. Professor Wu and Professor Almazbek discussed about the future cooperation at the meeting. Professor Almazbek also introduced himself and APAPKR briefly. Both of the President from AAPA and APAPKR agreed to co-organize doctoral workshops in the future. At the meeting, Professor Wu and Professor Almazbek also talked about and updated the related issues Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which aims at promoting the research and the education in the area of public administration.






3.4 Attend meetings hosted by PSPA, ASPA, KAPA and etc.

From April 9-15, 2021, we participated in the 2021 Annual Meeting of the American Society for Public Administration (ASPA) which was held online with the theme:




